

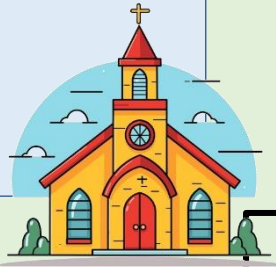
History

Somewhere you visit with your family

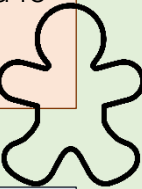


Science

Research Molly Haslund. Create your own circles using different materials (e.g. chalk, sticks, paint).

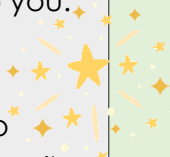


RE
